Weatherby: Gene and Janice reported that a severe rain and wind storm devastated their region in early August. As Gene and Janice continue their labour of love in these unfortunate circumstances, pray that the Gospel will be revealed to the amaXhosa people.

Belovicz: Micheal, Angela and their children, Adrian, Whitney and Spencer are settling into their new surroundings in Bolivia. School grades indicate that the children are enjoying school and adjusting well to the changes. A house has become available for lease and a contract is in progress. Pray for favour in finalizing the deal.

Reigert: Ken & Nancy and their ministry team request prayer for protection and wisdom. There have been numerous incidents of theft and muggings. On one occasion, the van their producer was riding in was stopped by bandits with machine guns and all passengers were robbed of cash. Several team members are facing health issues; pray that lumps will be benign, that eyes will heal from cataract surgery, and that a healthy baby will be born. Most of all, pray that the Gospel will spread. There is an urgent need for funding to continue the program ministry to unreached tribes. Pray that God will meet these needs.

The house is almost completed, but with the windows running behind schedule, and Ian doing most of the work by himself, we need to pray that the project will be completed in a timely manner. The couple buying the house has agreed to let Ian use it as a showcase home for the house he plans to build next year. We praise God for blessing this project.

Kokura: Pat continues to request prayer for a strong leader to join the team at Oaks of Righteousness. The young boys need a stable mentor to look up to as a Christian male role model. Pray that God will bring someone to them who, like the Apostle Paul, will say, "Follow me, even as I follow Christ!"

Farewell: Leigh Ross has returned home to the United States following the difficult decision to merge Arms of Love with Kingdom Kids Children's Home. We wish her all the best!

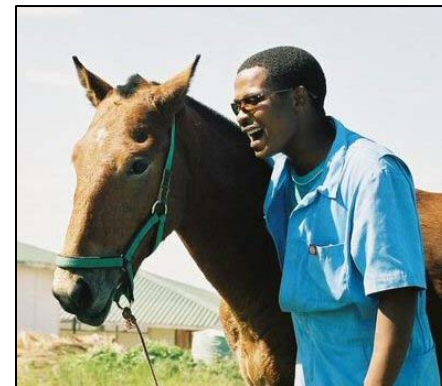
