Lewis: David and Christina and their sons were blessed as they attended the Mission Prep Course. Their boys were eager to go to 'school'. The Lewis's have had their departure for Zanzibar postponed to mid-January. Pray that their work permits will come so that they will be able to leave by their new departure date.

Belovicz: Adjusting to a new culture is a process that takes time and effort. Effectively impacting a new culture requires understanding the culture. Pray for Michael and Angela, and their family, as they learn the language and discover ways to minister effectively to the people around them.

Reigert: Pray for Ken & Nancy and other missionaries who are taking the gospel to unreached people.

Thrift Shop: Unanticipated road-blocks have brought the lease agreements for our thrift venture to an abrupt halt for the time being. Pray that God will make our way clear.

Sri Lanka: Beatings, attacks, and threats of violence continue to intimidate Christians. Schools have been warned by an anonymous group to cancel all Christmas programs, warning of 'stern' action if schools fail to comply. Police have been notified. Pray that believers will stand strong in their faith in spite of persecution.

Kenya: Lynette Ondiko was blessed to be able to attend a conference on children's ministry in Uganda, in late October. God provided the finances on the last day, making this possible. In spite of challenges and attacks from the enemy – at one point she thought she may need to wash dishes to earn money for her trip home – she had a wonderful time and returned to Kenya encouraged for her ministry. Pray that God will bless her with strength and courage as she deals with many women and children whose lives are scarred from abuse.

Canada: Eight summer-teen-campers are finalizing plans for their trip to Kenya in March 2007. Pray for the planning and preparation of this trip. Pray for the fall IATW board and budget meetings scheduled for November 17 and 18.

International Day of Prayer for the Persecuted Church: As men and women are persecuted in many places across the world, let's remember to pray for them. This special day of prayer, held on November 12 or 19,

I took a moment to visit the 'Voice of the Martyrs' website and discovered many of the stories there affect the countries where we work. If you want to be challenged and inspired, visit www.persecution.net and read the stories of Christians in Eritrea, Sri Lanka, India and other places in the world.

Eritrea: Persecution continues. Starting at 6 a.m. on Thursday October 25, security officers in the town of Mendefera went house to house, arresting local Christians from a list they compiled of known members of Pentecostal churches and the Orthodox renewal movement. Families were torn apart; mothers forced to leave behind their nursing infants. Of the 162 Christians arrested in the last month, at least two have been beaten to death. Pray for peace and protection as the Word of God spreads across this country.

Your Church: As the physical world is at war, pray that God will raise up 'warriors' who are willing to stand in the frontlines for the Gospel.
