Weatherby: We requested special prayer for Janice's health several weeks ago and received a praise report. She is feeling almost back to normal again. Thank you for praying! In the area of ministry, Gene and Janice have experienced some real break-through. Following the death of an elderly woman in the community, Gene was invited into a discussion with the men who expressed interest in learning the 'true way'. Pray that this 'thirst for Truth' will continue and bring many of the amaXhosa to Jesus

Lewis: We praise God that David and Christina have arrived safely in Tanzania. They are learning the Kiswahili language, with the special blessing of having the teacher come to their home so they can both learn the language while staying at home with their boys. They expect to have two classrooms completed within a week, and should be ready for school to begin in early April depending on how quickly the container makes it through customs. Pray that all will go well. People are already asking when the school will open so there should be no shortage of students.

White: Pray that Rehema House will be filled with children in need. Pray for strength and wisdom for Ian and Lynne in their ministry.

Kokura: Pray that the ongoing warfare and attacks of Satan will strengthen Pat and the ministry she is doing in Uganda. Pray that the two youth, who have been stealing from Pat, will repent and change their ways.

Reigert: Pray for Ken as he completes the latrine project he is currently working on. Since November, all but two thousand dollars of the nineteen thousand needed for the project, have been raised. When this is completed he will focus more on taking the gospel to the tribes in remote regions of the country. Pray that hearts will continue to soften and earch for truth.

Stairs: Pray for Marlene as she ministers in Kenya. She loves the country but misses family and friends. Pray that God will meet all her needs.

Belovicz: Pray that Micheal and Angela and their family will learn the language quickly and be able to communicate the Gospel effectively.

Sri Lanka: As unrest continues to devastate the country of Sri Lanka, let's not become desensitized and forget our brothers and sisters who suffer persecution at the hands of cruel men. Pray for peace.

Philippines: Awit Castillo is able to walk again following a stroke and is back in fulltime ministry. Pray for her left arm which is still paralysed. Pray that God will provide financially for all their needs on a personal and church level.

Dominican Republic

January has been a month of painful change for Rachel Sticklee and Leticia LeFrance. The death of Tita, a twenty-three-year-old who was their dear friend, as well as a real asset to La Tienda, has brought deep grief to the girls. In their grief they express joy in knowing that Tita accepted Jesus as her Saviour and is with him now.

Tita was diagnosed with AIDS and Tuberculosis in early December. Several weeks after the tests, Tita became very ill and was laid to rest in early January. Pray for Rachel and Letitia as they grieve the passing of their friend and for Tita's nine-year-old son Franki, who is also grieving this loss.

Pray for Letitia as she returns home in a few days and readjusts to 'American' culture. Letitia specifically requests prayer that she will not forget the people whom she has grown to love and whose suffering she has tasted – that they are real people that need our help.

Pray that Rachel as she continues her ministry without the support of Letitia. Pray that she will be refreshed and renewed and that her passion for Jesus and her compassion for the women will produce a great harvest for the kingdom of God.
