ZANZIBAR – David Lewis writes

"We have been receiving some verbal harassment by some of the Muslim leaders in the area, they have set up some loudspeakers at the half built mosque next to us and are warning the people not to have anything to do with us. Although it was "harmless" it was really loud, and definitely designed to harass us. This has been their second meeting, the first was on Friday, which is their holy day and was an "understandable" get together, but the second was today (Sunday) which made it seem more like harassment. So Fridays at 3PM local time (that is about 8AM EDT) we are planning a prayer walk through the community, and we would ask that you join us at the throne of God in prayer. Here are a few quick requests; 1. That the harassment will stop, 2. God will make people deaf to the lies coming from the loudspeakers at the mosque, 3. People will realize that we are "turning the other cheek" to this harassment, and finally; that those who feel threatened by us will come to the realization that they are indeed serving a false god and that the only path to paradise is found in the Son of God. Please also pray for all the work which needs to be done for school to begin July 1st.

NIGER –Bitrus Audu has returned from his second visit to Niger. Please pray for our new pastor Yohannes as he begins an outreach ministry in rural areas in this needy country.
