This was for building the next classroom to open in January. We currently have no building funds –so the finding or return of this money is important.

NIGERIA Bitrus writes that the Mafa and Ngoshe tribes are warring. He has sat with leaders of both groups – pray they will follow his advice to peace. Hajara, Danladi and Idrus are Muslim people in Niger who are fearful of following Christ. Pray for Gods guidance and peace.

NOV 7-11 there is a university student outreach in Ibadan (Nigeria) – 2000 students are expected. Pray for the organizers. Pray for 500 decisions for Christ and 100 to commit to becoming missionaries/church leaders.
