Following elections Dec 26th there has been great turmoil in the country – with rioting, burning, killings.

One of the most troubled areas is Kisumu. Ian and Lynne White at Rehema-Bukura children's home are near this area. It has been quite frightening at times. Pray for the Whites, their visitors, and wisdom for a visitor who was planning to visit in January.

Our teen mission team was to have visited Kenya in March but we have changed their mission to Zanzibar instead.

Ask God to bring about a peaceful solution to the election where there were irregularities in the electoral process.

WHEN THE WELL GOES DRY it means

our new short term worker, Larissa Warren (only in the country a few days) helps out by carrying water. The Zanzibari people were amazed to see a white person carrying water. The well has been dug a little deeper.

The spiritual lesson of course is that when we get dry we need to go deeper into God. Paul prayed in Ephesians 3 that we "might be strengthened by might by His spirit in the inner man, that Christ might dwell in your hearts by faith, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height, and to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge that you might be filled with all the fullness of God." Pray this for all our overseas workers."

Pat Kokura – in Uganda some of the boys have been stealing and acting out while Pat is on furlough. Pray for wisdom for the African staff to wisely care for the boys.

David and Christina Lewis in Zanzibar. Second semester has started with 118 students and 40 on the waiting list. Pray for wisdom in running the school, and in starting the two new Maasai churches.

Two Muslims in recent days have come and asked to become Christians. Pray for them as they start to walk in the way.

West Africa Bitrus writes – "please pray that we can find qualified teachers for our mission school in Karasude. Pray for our Bible School students. Classes began January 21."

India – Hallelujah writes that violence has greatly increased in the state of Orissa where VEI has over 20 churches.
