KENYA – after the rioting in January and February things have quieted down. There are still several hundred thousand in refugee camps. Joseph Mophat's church is working to assist in the camps – any donations can be sent to our office.

Whites were not able to take any more children as there is a problem with the social worker that must be solved by the government. It is alleged she sold a child for about \$300. Until that is solved no more children can be taken from the Kakamega hospital. Nine children are waiting. Whites ask for prayer for this situation as well as for Gods guidance to the Rehema board and staff while they are home in Canada in May and June.

ZANZIBAR – construction is starting again on the 3 new classrooms due to several generous donations. Pray for the work to be done well and in good time.

There is a growing number of Muslim Background Believers. (M.B.B.) They have little understanding of the Gospel – we are attempting to set up special meetings for them in a house in the city where they can be discipled and encouraged in their faith. Please pray for these needs. Pray that the long time Christians from the mainland will understand their new M.B.B.

Please also pray for the possibility of new land either beside the school or across the road. The school is doing well but we appreciate prayers for the teachers and students.
